<p&gt;Two versions of 4, £ Omaha are commonly played around the world, Pot Li
mit Omaha and Omaha Hi-Lo (aka Omaha Eight or Better). The next 4, £ sections wi

<p&gt;Omaha Hi Lo Rules Overview&lt;/p&gt;
<p&gt;Omaha 8, also known 4, £ as Omaha Eight or Better, or Omaha high low sp
lit ('Hi/Lo'), is a split pot game. The best high hand 4, £ wins half of
the pot, and the best low hand wins the other half of the pot.</p&gt;
<p&gt;Much like its cousin, 4, £ Pot Limit Omaha, Omaha 8 or Better involves
four hole cards for each player. The object of Omaha 8 is 4, £ to make the best
five-card high hand, and/or best five-card low hand, using exactly two hole card
s and three community 4, £ cards. Different combinations of cards can be used by
a player to make separate high and low hands.</p&gt;
<p&gt;It is possible 4, £ for a player to win both the high and low portions
of the pot--known as "scooping". If there is no 4, £ qualifying low ha
nd (five cards below 8), the best high hand will scoop the whole pot.</p&gt; &lt;p&gt;Omaha 8 can be played 4, £ as a limit, pot limit or even no limit game.
The most common variant is Limit Omaha 8 or Better, 4, £ which is also the vari

d, and the player two to the left of the 4, £ button puts in the big blind. Each
player is dealt four cards face down, starting with the player to the 4, £ left
